

## Instructions for Completing Dual Credit Paperwork

### **Students**

- 1. Please use blue or black ink (not pencil)
- 2. Press firmly and make sure all information is printed clearly and legibly.

## **Teachers**

Once you have received students' completed forms:

- 1. Separate the Permission to Test forms from the Applications for Admission.
- 2. Alphabetize each stack of forms separately.
- 3. Sign the Permission to Test forms as the school official.
- 4. Provide a printed roster of all students who will be testing (legal names, not nicknames), along with their email addresses.
- 5. Email the roster and both sets of alphabetized forms to testing@volstate.edu and dualenrollment@volstate.edu. You may also fax them to 615-230-3473.

#### NOTE:

Students will be required to pay the \$25 test administration fee prior to testing.

#### Payment options:

  - Call the Testing Center at 615-230-3484 to pay by debit or credit card.
- On Test Day
  - Bring cash, check, or money order made payable to VSCC.

Students are notified, however, that only the Social Security number may be used as an identifier for grants, loans, and other financial aid programs according to federal regulations. The student's Social Security number will not be disclosed to individuals or agencies outside Volunteer State Community College except in accordance with institutional policy on student records.
