

Surplus Property Condition Codes

<u>CODE</u>	<u>CONDITION DESCRIPTION</u>
EX	<u>NEW OR UNUSED PROPERTY</u> IN EXCELLENT CONDITION; INTERCHANGEABLE WITH NEW. ITEMS DELIVERED BY A MANUFACTURER OR NORMAL MANUFACTURER OR NORMAL SOURCE OF SUPPLY.
GD	NEW OR UNUSED PROPERTY IN GOOD CONDITION. PROPERTY MAY BE SLIGHTLY SHOPWORN, SOILED BUT UTILITY IS NOT IMPAIRED. USED PROPERTY IN GOOD CONDITION WITH NO REPAIRS REQUIRED OR WHICH HAS BEEN REPAIRED OR RENOVATED.
FR	NEW OR UNUSED PROPERTY IN FAIR CONDITION. PROPERTY MAY BE SOILED, SHOPWORN, RUSTED, DETERIORATED, WORN, OR DAMAGED TO THE EXTENT THAT UTILITY IS SLIGHTLY IMPAIRED. USED PROPERTY REQUIRING MINOR REPAIRS.
PR	USED PROPERTY THAT EITHER HAS OR HASN'T BEEN REPAIRED OR RENOVATED IN THE PAST, BUT IT HAS DETERIORATED TO THE EXTENT THAT UTILITY IS IMPAIRED. USED PROPERTY REQUIRING MAJOR REPAIRS.
OB	USED PROPERTY SO BADLY DAMAGED THAT IT IS UNECONOMICAL TO REPAIR, AND CONDITION OR USAGE WOULD BE QUESTIONABLE AFTER REPAIR.
SV	SALVAGE - PERSONAL PROPERTY WITH SOME VALUE IN EXCESS OF IT'S BASIC MATERIAL CONTENT THAT COULD BE UTILIZED TO REPAIR OTHER UNITS. SCRAP - PROPERTY THAT HAS NO VALUE EXCEPT FOR ITS BASIC MATERIAL CONTENT.
