Preparing Students for High Demand Clinical Occupations

COE has three very engaged cohorts studying Clinical Medical Assistant and Phlebotomy Technician between our Gallatin campus and our Upper Cumberland region, specifically in Celina. All programs require classroom and laboratory studies, online modules, and clinical externships before students sit for their national certification exams. Following course completion and certification, students became employed at physician practices and hospital laboratories. In addition, some graduates choose to further their education in areas



such as nursing, while working in their current certified clinical roles.

We have two additional courses starting in April in Gallatin, with plans to continue offering courses at our Upper Cumberland and Springfield campus locations.
