### Program Description:

Participants in the Certified Safety & Health Official Certificate Program must complete a minimum of nine (9) courses, comprised of required and elective courses, which include a minimum of 175.5 contact hours of training through OTI Education Center courses to earn the *Certified Safety & Health Official Construction Industry* certificate.

- must complete six (6) Required Courses from the Construction Industry list for a minimum of 148.0 contact hours of training.
- must complete a minimum of three (3) Elective Courses from the industry list that include a minimum of 27.5 contact hours of training.
- A minimum of 2 courses, or 52 hours of training, must have been taken with the OTI Education Center at Volunteer State Community College.
  - ❖ Other required and elective courses may be transferred from any OSHA Training Institute Education Center.
  - ❖ Proof of successful course completion is required.
