## PRIDE ONLINE SUPPORT - REGISTRATION

We are excited about your decision to continue your studies at Volunteer State Community College, and we want to make your registration process as smooth as possible. This information will help you properly navigate through our registration system. If the information doesn't address an issue you are having with your registration process, there are three offices that may be able to help you.

- Advising Center - 615-230-3702 (help with non-technical issues such as holds on your account)
- IT Help Desk - 615-230-3302 (help with technical issues such as getting your PIN reset)
- Information Desk - 615-230-3544 (all other Pride Online issues)

### Logging In to the Registration System

1. Get to the Pride Online login page (<http://www.volstate.edu/PRIDE>).
2. The "V" in your User ID must always be upper case. Your initial PIN will also only use upper case letters. If you have already created a new PIN, it will be case sensitive and will use whatever mix of numbers and upper & lower case letters you have created.
3. Click the "Login" button to enter the system
4. If you see the Invalid User ID or PIN error, make sure you used your V Number for your User ID, not your e-mail User ID.

### Reasons for an invalid ID or PIN:

The most common problem is an error referring to an invalid ID or PIN. Here are a few pointers for addressing those issues. Make sure you are using your "V Number". This should be a capital V followed by an 8 digit number. Confirm letters or numbers in ID and PIN on the following: the number "0" (zero) or the letter "O" as in (Oscar) ; the number "1", or is it a letter "I" as in (lima) or an "l" as in (India).

### Finding Classes

Once you are logged in to the system there are several things you can do:

1. You should see the Main Menu, go to the "Student" tab for registration
2. Click the "Registration" link at the top of the Student menu
3. From the Registration menu, click on the "Look Up Classes" link
4. Select the term for which you wish to register from the drop down form, and click the Submit button
5. You must select a "Subject". All other criteria are optional in boxes other than Subject. You may hold down the CTRL key when clicking to select more than one item from the list.
6. Make your selections and click the "Class Search" button.
