TRIO Student Support Services

Start-to-Finish (S2F) College Seminar:

S2F is a required orientation for new TRIO students. They are available during the fall and spring semesters.

Goal Planning System (GPS): Assists students with setting and achieving long-term and short-term personal, academic and career goals.

Academic Advising: General advising, course selection and early registration will be available. New and returning TRIO students may qualify for priority registration.

Tutoring/Academic Planning:

Individual/group tutoring services available. Individual Academic Plans are developed with students and staff.

Supplemental Instruction: Academic support outside of the classroom with tutors and staff will be available for students as needed.

Financial Literacy: TRIO's financial literacy program, will focus on Personal Budgeting, Financial Aid, and Future Planning. Limited TRIO Retention Scholarships will be given to deserving TRIO students.

Transfer Planning: Assistance with admissions process, financial aid and transfer info. Four-year college campus tours available. Peer mentoring available.

Peer Mentoring: Selected individuals will serve as role models for new TRIO students. They will be sophomores or TRIO Alumni.

Graduation Planning: Students are assisted with major selection and course outlines for each semester. Graduation audits and applications are provided.

Career Planning: Career assessments and counseling available to assist students with exploring career options and creating career plans.

Technology Access: Students may check out a laptop, calculator and/or digital recorder on a monthly basis. There is a TRIO lab with four computers and a student printer.

Cultural Enrichment: Cultural trips, activities and events provided educational experiences from a global perspective.
