

Advising Humanities

These are some things to consider when advising Humanities students

EMP Programs: For all students, including those who need all or some Learning Support, there are some critical courses to consider in the Fall Semester to follow the recommended curriculum. LS support classes can be added and continued in subsequent semesters including summer to graduate in 4 or 5 semesters.

- **Music Business:** EMPR 1125, EMPR 1270, MUS 1002
 - Notice in catalog *only Comm 2045* listed for Speech requirements*
- **Music Production:** EMPR 1125, EMPR 1270, MUS 1002
 - Notice in catalog *only Comm 2045* listed for Speech requirements*
- **Video Production:** EMPR 1125, EMPR 1212, COMM 2020
 - Take Art 1340 in Spring - Pre-req for ART 253
 - Notice in catalog *only Comm 2045* listed for Speech requirements*
- * If a student completed *COMM 2025*, may ask for a substitution.

Art Studio AFA: For all students including those with LS needs - Take in Fall:

- Art 1045
- Art 1340

English AA or Foreign Language AA - Take in Fall:

- 12 Credits (4 Semesters) in a single Foreign Language are required. Should start in Fall semester.

Music AFA – Take in Fall:

- Mus 1002 or Placement Test (Needed as pre-req for Mus 1057 and 1058 in Spring)
 - Consult with Music chair, or designated staff if a placement music test is available. See Degree Works pre-req sections.
