

# **Vol State Course Alignment with Targeted TDOE CTE Programs**

Law, Public Safety, Corrections, & Security: Fire Management Services

### **Action Steps**

- Review Vol State CTE-aligned courses and credentials below.
- Request sample syllabuses if additional course information is needed.
- Contact the Dual Enrollment Office at <u>dualenrollment@volstate.edu</u> to explore questions and next steps:
  - Credentialing a high school faculty member to teach the dual enrollment course.
  - Discuss course type (university parallel vs. vocational/career)
  - o Discuss the purpose of the course and/or transferability of courses
- Ensure the required facilities, equipment, and software are available for in-person classes at the high school.
  - Fire Science Students need to have their own classroom, with ample space for the students and space for the tools and equipment required to support the program.



## **Regarding Course Instructors for Fire Science Programs**

The key to a successful program is selecting the right teacher. A successful teacher will:

- Be employed by the respective school system.
- At a minimum, hold an Associate Degree in Fire Science or related program. A bachelor's degree is preferred.
- Have several years of experience as a full-time firefighter.
- Establish a good professional and personal relationship with the community's fire department.

#### Notes about Fire Management Services at Vol State through Dual Enrollment

- Benefits that students can expect to gain from Fire Science Dual Enrollment program:
  - o Knowledge and training of a needed trade in all communities across the country
  - College credit that can lead to a college degree, which provides pay incentives at many middle Tennessee fire departments.
  - o A sense of community
- What the Fire Science Dual Enrollment program will not do:
  - o Put students in hazardous/emergency situations.
  - Guarantee a job in the fire service industry.
